Revised COVID-19 Recommendations:

Now that we have a better sense of how the Club functions under COVID-19 conditions, the Board's Executive Committee has revised its recommendations for the 2020 season to emphasize a few points. These points are not just "good sense," but follow current public health guidelines:

1. Wear a mask when arriving at and leaving from the club. Remember, it is possible to be a carrier of the virus, and not have any symptoms at all! Wearing a mask is a common courtesy to your fellow members; it protects them from you, just as you want to be protected from them.
2. Maintain the recommended distancing of six to ten feet between players (even in doubles). When changing sides, don't crowd one side of the court, but choose opposite sides (i.e., ad or deuce court) to move to the other side.
3. If you are socializing on court (taking a break, chatting), maintain social distancing. For off-court socializing, please wear a mask and maintain distancing.
4. After using the brooms or touching any surfaces (e.g., the gates), use hand-sanitizer, or wash your hands thoroughly.
5. Consider playing with family members or others you know to have maintained quarantine. If you choose to play doubles, use discretion in choosing partners.
